Expanding Impact Through Accreditation

CSI Accreditation continues to experience significant growth, particularly in school choice states where more Christian schools are seeking trusted guidance and accountability as they establish and strengthen their programs. We have developed an innovative provisional accreditation pathway that walks alongside schools experiencing accreditation for the first time.

Investing in Educators, Impacting Students

The experienced CSI staff support schools across the CSI network in their shared mission of helping students know and understand God and his world. One of the most important ways we support that mission is through professional learning opportunities for teachers and school leaders.

Each year, hundreds of educators participate in professional learning events designed to strengthen their understanding of Christian education and equip them to lead and teach with purpose. These experiences help educators grow in wisdom, sharpen leadership skills, and rediscover how every subject and student story fits within God's greater story. Rooted in biblical truth and authentic learning, these events prepare educators to guide students toward lives of service, curiosity, and faith.

Supporting School Leaders for *Lasting Impact*

Our consultative services, led by seasoned school leader, Terry Kok, often provides situational advice for school leaders. Answering those calls has been noted as a distinct benefit of membership by our community. Whether it be guiding schools through strategic planning, leadership searches, governance training, or policy development, Terry and our team of consultants work closely with the CSI team to support our network of schools.

In the past year, Terry has spoken directly with more than forty schools, providing support to approximately half of them. This hands-on assistance and seasoned guidance have been especially helpful to new school leaders, new board members, and schools navigating times of crisis. This important work makes a big difference in the lives of Christian schools.

Partnerships that Strengthen *Christian Schools*

Providing meaningful resources for schools remains a priority for Christian Schools International. At the same time, we recognize that no single organization can meet every need on its own.

This year, CSI launched a sponsor partnership program designed to connect schools with trusted, mission-aligned organizations offering valuable products and services. These partnerships provide support in areas such as school furnishings, campus security, leadership, board governance, and advancement—all through companies that share a commitment to Christian education.

The impact of these partnerships extends directly to our member schools.

Revenue generated through the sponsor program helps provide scholarships for CSI learning events and offers emergency assistance to schools facing unexpected challenges. 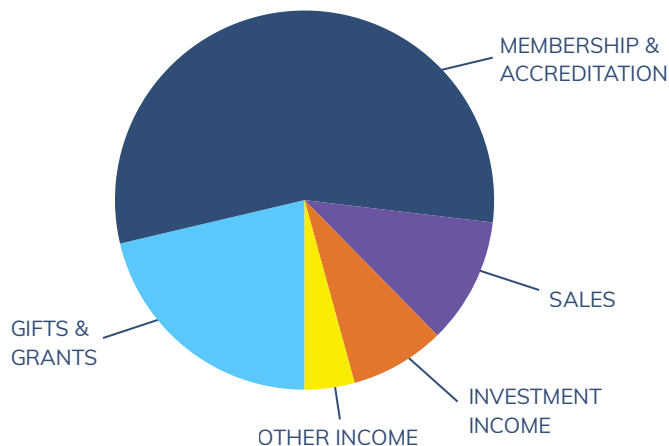
